2025 European Semester Spring Package sets out guidance to boost EU competitiveness

The <u>2025 European Semester Spring Package</u> provides tailored policy guidance to Member States to boost EU competitiveness, resilience, and prosperity.

It aligns national reforms with the

Competitiveness Compass and includes

country-specific recommendations (CSRs)

focused on innovation, decarbonisation,

defence capabilities, and skills development.

It also supports increased defence spending

via the National Escape Clause.

Commission provides guidance on the implementation of NextGenerationEU – The road to 2026

The European Commission has issued new guidance to help Member States successfully close the Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF) by its **2026 deadline,** urging them to revise their plans to include only measures achievable by 31 August 2026 and to prepare for final payments by 31 December 2026.

With **over €335 billion still available**, the Commission stresses the need for accelerated implementation and offers a clear menu of options to optimise use of remaining funds.




Figure 2: Overall distribution of reforms by key policy domains, in % of total number of reforms (total= 1,131) (*)





Matchmaking in UAE Event 2025 – 1-3 October 2025



The <u>EU-UAE Matchmaking Event</u> will take place in Dubai from 1–3 October 2025, organised by the European Commission via the ECCP alongside UAE authorities and in the context of WETEX. 

Supporting the clean energy transition of European industry and businesses

- This call aims to support coordination and support actions that accelerate the clean energy transition across Europe by promoting energy efficiency, renewable energy uptake, and climate neutrality.
- Target key areas:
 - Building renovation
 - Decarbonisation of industry and heating systems
 - Energy skills and financing solutions
 - Addressing energy poverty, contributing to the EU's 2030 energy and climate targets and the European Green Deal.

Advanced manufacturing technologies for leadership of EU manufacturers in products for the net-zero industry

- The objective of the call is to boost the EU's strategic autonomy and clean tech capacity through advanced manufacturing technologies for **net-zero industries**.
- Focus areas:
 - Manufacturing for strategic net-zero technologies
 - Additive & advanced manufacturing, automation, surface processing
 - Digital twins, circularity, and low environmental impact
- Proposals must include a strong business case and exploitation strategy to demonstrate their
 market potential and path to industrial deployment. The business case should outline the targeted
 market, user needs, competitive advantage, and expected impact in the EU.

Additional activities for the European Partnership Water Security for the Planet (Water4All)

- This call supports the demonstration of innovative, cost-effective solutions to fully replace fossil fuels in industrial plants with high heating demands by locally integrating **renewable energy sources**
- Projects should enhance energy efficiency, process flexibility, and storage, while reducing emissions and reliance on the electricity grid.
- The solution must be **physically demonstrated** in an industrial setting, scalable, and tailored to meet the common needs of the sector across the EU and Associated Countries.
- Proposals must include a **strong business model** and exploitation strategy to support broad deployment and ensure competitiveness.
