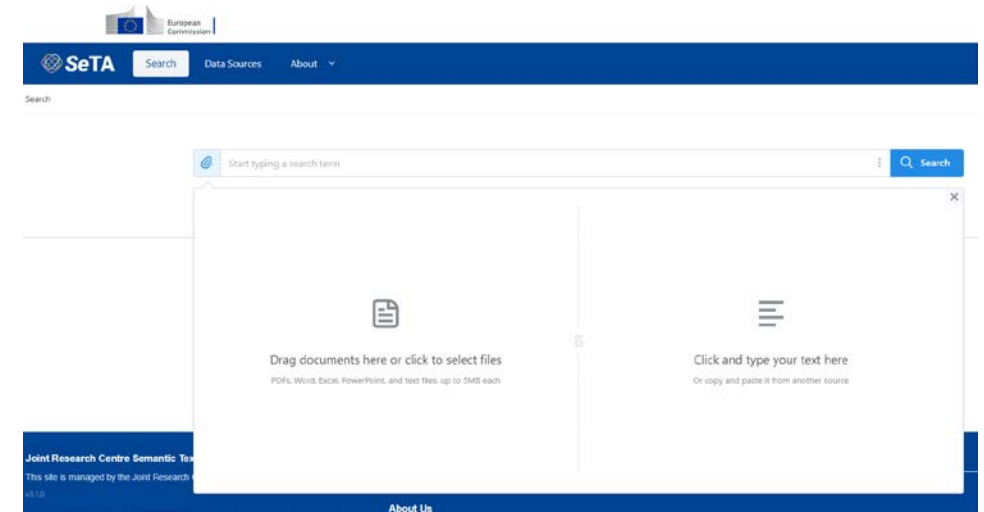

Question: What are the barriers to learning mobility?

Answer: Enhancing learning mobility in the European Union is a key aspect of the EU's education and training policy. The goal is promoting greater mobility of students, teachers, and other education and training professionals within the EU.

Question: What are the future plans for promoting learning mobility?

Answer: The European Commission plans to propose a new policy in 2023 to promote learning mobility for everyone in the European Education Area.

Background

Learning mobility refers to the movement of learners and educators between educational institutions within or outside the EU. This can include study abroad programs, exchange programs, and other forms of international study. It also includes the movement of teachers and other education and training professionals, the movement of young people for the purpose of apprenticeships or traineeships, and the movement of adult learners for the purpose of participating in formal and non-formal learning activities.

The European Commission aims to make learning mobility a reality for everyone, regardless of age, level of education, background, and financial means. This is seen as a priority for citizens in Europe. The Commission believes that learning mobility can enhance intercultural competences and participation in citizenship, and can contribute to positive attitudes about the EU and to the development of a European identity.

The European Commission plans to promote the expansion of learning mobility to encourage Member States to make mobility experiences a valued part of all education and training pathways. The Commission's plans also include raising the target for higher education graduates with mobility experience and for vocational learners participating in mobility programmes.

Enhancing learning mobility in the EU can bring numerous benefits. These include cultural and linguistic diversity, personal development, improved employability, networking and career opportunities, and international cooperation and understanding. Mobility programs can expose individuals to different cultures, languages and ways of thinking, which can broaden their perspectives and foster intercultural understanding.

There are, however, barriers to learning mobility. These include lack of knowledge about learning mobility, economic, social, cultural or geographic constraints, and language barriers. The European Commission is working to overcome these barriers and provide incentives to improve access to transnational learning mobility.

The European Commission is proposing a Council Recommendation on a renewed learning mobility framework as a key building block of the European Education Area. The Commission is calling on member states to integrate learning mobility into all education and training sectors. The goal is to broaden access so that more students can benefit, including those with disabilities and limited opportunities.

The European AI Act

Risk-Based Framework

- **Prohibited**
AI systems threatening rights (e.g. social scoring)
- **High-Risk**
AI in critical areas (e.g. recruitment, finance, health, public services)
- **Limited Risk**
AI with transparency obligations (e.g. chatbots)
- **Minimal Risk**
AI uses with no or low regulatory requirements



The European AI Act in Practice

Scope & Risk Classification

- Identify AI systems used in your cluster (e.g. chatbots, analytics engines)
- Classify them by risk level: Minimal, Limited, High or Prohibited

Key Obligations for High-Risk Systems

- Appoint a Responsible Person for Compliance
- Conduct Data Governance & Quality Assessments

Transparency & Member Rights

- Provide clear “AI in use” disclosures to members and partners
- Enable human-over-the-loop review for important decisions
- Establish processes for individuals to challenge AI-driven outcomes
